### **BOD APPROVES HALF YEAR RESULTS AS OF JUNE 30<sup>TH</sup>, 2015**

- Consolidated Revenues at 82.1 Euro million (+13% vs. 1H 2014)
- Consolidated EBITDA at 7.5 Euro million (+9% vs. 1H 2014)
- Result before taxes at 1.4 Euro million (+65% vs. 1H 2014)
- Net result at break-even (vs. the profit of 0.8 Euro million as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014)
- Net financial debt at 43 Euro million vs. 30 Euro million as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014 and vs. 27 Euro million as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014, mainly due to the increase of Net working capital

*Milan, August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2015* – The Board of Directors of Isagro S.p.A. approved today the Consolidated Interim Financial Statements as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015, which will be made available to the public at the Company's headquarters, on the corporate website <a href="www.isagro.com">www.isagro.com</a> and at the centralized storage mechanism "eMarket Storage", on the web site <a href="www.emarketstorage.com">www.emarketstorage.com</a>.

#### 2015 first half consolidated results

In the first half of 2015 Isagro registered a turnover of 82.1 Euro million, with a 9.2 Euro million increase (+13%) vs. 72.9 Euro million of the same period of last year; such improvement took place in a context of generalized sales growth of all the main products marketed by the Group, especially in Italy, mainly with reference to copper products, and in Asia, also thanks to the strengthening of the Indian Rupee against Euro.

2015 first half EBITDA was equal to 7.5 Euro million, up by 0.6 Euro million (+9%) vs. 6.9 Euro million as of June  $30^{th}$ , 2014.





Such an increase appears limited, in absolute terms, if compared to the sales growth, due to higher R,I&D costs expensed at P&L and fixed costs. On this regards, personnel costs amounted to 14.8 Euro million, up by 0.7 Euro million vs. same period of last year due, on one side, to HR rationalization for 0.2 Euro million in Isagro S.p.A. and, on the other side, to the strengthening of the Indian Rupee at Isagro Asia level.

The half-year Net result was, then, influenced by:

- net losses from exchange rates and hedging instruments for 1.3 Euro million (vs. a net loss of 14
  Euro thousands of 2014 first half); such losses derived from the contracts put in place to hedge the
  budgeted 12-month sales in USD, with first half sales lower than 20% of the total year expected
  amount;
- higher current and deferred taxes vs. first half 2014 for 1.2 Euro million, mainly due to (i) higher income taxes (mostly referred to the growing result of Isagro Asia), (ii) the presence, as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014, of a 0.4 Euro million fiscal reimbursement at Isagro USA level and (iii) the absence of accruals of deferred taxes at credit relevant to the fiscal loss of Isagro S.p.A., which, instead, were accrued in the first half of 2014.

Consequently, the Net result as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015 is positive for 21 Euro thousand vs. 0.8 Euro million of 2014 first half.

Consolidated Net financial position as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015 amounted to 43.4 Euro million (with a NWC of 58.7 Euro million), versus 29.7 Euro million (with a NWC of 46.4 Euro million) as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014 and versus 26.5 Euro million (with a NWC of 46.4 Euro million) as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014, with a Debt/Equity ratio equal to 0.44 (versus the value of 0.31 as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014 and the value of 0.28 as of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014).



### Perspectives for the current year

In the light of 2015 first half-year results and of the estimates and the objectives for the second half, which include the assumption of 4 Euro million revenues from Licensing, Isagro estimates an EBITDA of around 18 Euro million for the full year, in line with 2014-2018 Business Plan communicated to the Market.

**Isagro S.p.A.** is the holding company of a group which, in twenty years, has become a qualified operator in the agrochemicals business, with global sales of around € 150 million and over 600 employees worldwide. Listed on the Italian Stock Exchange since 2003, Isagro is active in the innovative research, development, production and marketing, on a worldwide scale, of proprietary agrochemicals, as well as in their distribution in some key markets.
